#### MEET DR. ELIMARYS PEREZ-COLON



Dr. Elimarys Perez-Colon, affectionately known as Dr. PC by residents and students, is a double board-certified Internal Medicine and Pediatrics Hospital Medicine physician at TGH. She holds the positions of Associate Professor of Internal Medicine at USF MCOM, USF Med-Peds Residency Associate Program Director (APD), TGH Chief of Internal Medicine, and Co-Chair of the Internal Medicine Diversity, Inclusion, and Community Engagement committee. Originally from Villalba, Puerto Rico, Dr. PC pursued her medical education at the San Juan Bautista School of Medicine in Puerto Rico, followed by residency in USF Internal Medicine-Pediatrics. Dr. PC is deeply passionate about clinical education, using her role as an APD to enhance learner education and patient care. She actively engages in global health and health disparity work, volunteering at free clinics, leading disaster relief projects, and participating in medical trips to various countries. Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) are central to Dr. PC's mission, as she serves on multiple DEI committees at USF, focusing on recruitment, inclusion initiatives, curriculum, community efforts, and mentoring pipelines. Beyond her medical pursuits, Dr. PC enjoys traveling, photography, cooking, event planning, hiking, interior design, Latin dancing, and creative expression through Instagram. Working with LMSA, Dr. PC looks forward to mentoring like-minded students, working to increase representation in medicine, and spearheading projects to address health disparities in communities. As part of the 6% of practicing physicians identifying as Hispanic/Latin in the United States, you play a vital role in addressing disparities. Use your voice and expertise to educate, advocate, and inspire; people listen to physicians, and you can make a significant impact.
