MEET DR. TERESA BAKER



Dr. Teresa Baker is currently an Assistant Professor in the Department of Psychiatry. Dr. Baker obtained a bachelor's degree in psychology from the University of California, Los Angeles. As an undergraduate student, she volunteered for 3 years at Clínica Romero, a free clinic in Los Ángeles which provides health services to low income individuals. There she learned the positive impact a physician makes in people's lives. This further fueled her desire to pursue a medical career. After completing the post-bac program, MEDPREP, at Southern Illinois University, she completed her medical degree there in 2010. Her psychiatry residency training was at the University of South Florida Morsani College of Medicine. For the past 8 years, Dr. Baker has been serving the Tampa community treating various psychiatric conditions. Her main interests include the treatment of mood and anxiety disorders. As a bilingual provider, a significant portion of her patient population is Spanish speaking. She has been the recipient of the Patient Experience Award for the last 2 years in a row. In the clinical setting, she enjoys being a mentor and teacher to undergraduate students, medical students and psychiatry residents. Dr. Baker is a member of a few academic medical school committees. She also serves as a coach for medical students in the SELECT program. In addition, she supervises medical students in the Bridge Clinic, a student-run free clinic located at USF that serves uninsured adults from underserved communities. She is passionate about delivering quality psychiatric care and mentoring the next generation of doctors. The advice she would give medical students is "Be true to your core values and invest time and energy in your professional relationships, which will allow you to have guidance and support as you embark on this medical career journey."
