LMSA Faculty Spotlight



MEET DR. ANGELICA RIVERA-CRUZ

Dr. Rivera-Cruz was born and raised in Puerto Rico. She obtained her MD at the University of Puerto Rico and completed her Neurology residency at the same institution. She was heavily involved in different leadership positions, from being a resident member of the Graduate Medical Education Committee to Chief Resident of Neurology. She then moved to the U.S to complete a fellowship in Clinical Neurophysiology at the University of South Florida, followed by an Epilepsy Fellowship at Emory University.

Dr. Rivera-Cruz is currently an Assistant Professor of Neurology at the University of South Florida. She is the lead epileptologist of the intracranial EEG program (stereo-EEG). Her main interests are in the diagnosis and management of drug-resistant seizures, Critical Care EEG monitoring, neuro-modulation, and autoimmune seizures. She has co-authored several publications, book chapters, and is the Principal Investigator of several clinical trials for drug-resistant seizures.

Dr. Rivera-Cruz also serves as the Associate program director of the Clinical Neurophysiology fellowship and the Assistant Clerkship Director of Neurology. She was recently appointed as the Vice Chief of neurology at Tampa General Hospital. She has a strong interest in medical education and teaches several courses each year. More recently, she joined the Latino Medical Student Association and serves as a Neurology mentor. She was recognized by Castle Connolly as a Top Hispanic and Latino Doctor. Finally, Dr. Rivera-Cruz is an avid Crossfitter, enjoys running, dancing, and visiting her family in Puerto Rico.




Hispanic Heritage Month: Teaching at Williams Middle School (need medical students)


