#### MEET DR. LISVET LUCENO



Dr. Lisvet Luceno is a second-year resident in Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University of South Florida. As the daughter of Cuban immigrants, she is passionate about diversifying the OBGYN workforce and women's health advocacy. She holds leadership positions within Graduate Medical Education as a Culture, Enrichment, and Engagement (CEE) Champion and serves as Secretary/Treasurer for the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) District covering the state of Florida.

Dedicated to advancing education and research, Dr. Luceno has presented her work on Hypertensive Disorders of Pregnancy at the National ACOG Conference and played a key role in revamping her residency program's curriculum. She also mentors students through the Latino Medical Student Association at USF and co-organized the first joint OBGYN, Pediatrics, and Internal Medicine co-mixer for underrepresented applicants in medicine.

Her research interests include the utility of ultrasound in obstetrics, optimizing postpartum care, and enhancing resident education. Committed to advocacy, she plans to participate in State Advocacy Day in Tallahassee, championing women's healthcare rights in Florida. She has also contributed to community outreach efforts, including volunteering at Judeo-Christian Women's Health Night.

A South Florida native, Dr. Luceno enjoys spending time outdoors, especially with her Aussie-Lab mix, Reign. She can often be found walking along Bayshore Boulevard or visiting the Davis Island dog beach. She is a member of ACOG and AOA, holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Pennsylvania, and earned her medical degree from the University of Central Florida. Her advice to medical students is to remember that their unique perspectives and experiences have the power to make a difference. The world needs diverse voices in medicine, so stay resilient, advocate for others, and siempre pa'lante!


# **Faculty Mentors**
